Extra Services:

Hot lunch: Catered lunch service is available by semester subscription.

IB exams: Exam fees required by the IB Organization will be invoiced in December depending on the examination subjects chosen by the student.

Transportation: is not provided by the school. A number of private providers organize door to door transportation in the greater Florentine area. Drivers' contact details are available upon request.

Uniform: The School's uniform provider is **10 e Lode (Top Marks)**, conveniently located between the two schools at **Via Ugucione della Faggiola n°13 (near the Coop in Gavinana)**. Parents may visit **10 e Lode beginning in the Spring to order school uniforms for the academic year of 2017-2018**. School fees are billed once a year in July or August according to the payment plan options chosen as noted below:

Fees for attendance for the first semester only or one trimester are 60% of annual tuition plus 100% of Application, Registration and Capital Fund fees. Fees for attendance for the second semester only or portion of are 60% of annual tuition plus 60% of Registration and Capital Fund fees plus 100% of other fees. For partial attendance of the second semester, a student is not entitled to a refund of the tuition paid. In order to guarantee a space for your child or children for the following school year, a Deposit and Re-enrollment Fee must be paid in March. Subsequently, the Deposit will be deducted from the tuition.

For early departures - before December - due only to official transfer of a family from Florence, tuition fees will be prorated to one semester. For departures in the second semester, fees are due for the whole year.

Please be aware that:

- a. Due to Italian law, the school can only accept payment in cash up to € 2,999.99
- b. Credit card payments will not be accepted.

All late payments are subject to a 0.80% per month charge.

Example: Tuition € 15,000

Capital fund Fee & registration Fee of € 5,000 = a total of € 20,000

1. Full payment of € 19,400 by **31 July, 2017** (with a 3% discount)
2. 60% payment of € 12,000 by **10 September 2017** & 40% payment of € 8,000 by **10 January 2018**
3. 40% payment of € 8,000 by **10 September 2017** adding then 2% on the balance due:
 - 20% by **31 October 2017** of € 4,080
 - 20% by **31 December 2017** of € 4,080
 - 20% by **28 February 2018** of € 4,080
