Extra Services:

Hot lunch: Catered lunch service is available at the Junior School by semester subscription. At the Upper School the ISF Cafè provides daily hot lunches upon individual request. The food provider is [SIAF Care](#).

Transportation: Transportation is not provided by the school. A number of private providers organize door to door transportation in the greater Florentine area. Drivers' contact details are available upon request. School takes no responsibility in the organization or the quality of this service.

Uniform: The School's uniform provider is **10 e Lode**, conveniently located between the two schools at **Via Ugucione della Faggiola n°13 (near the Coop in Gavinana)**. Parents may visit **10 e Lode** beginning in the **Spring to order school uniforms for the academic year of 2020-2021**. Fees – important information

For partial attendance of the second semester, a student is not entitled to a refund of the tuition fee paid. In order to guarantee a space for your child/ren for the following school year, a Re-enrollment Fee must be paid in March, together with the first instalment of the tuition fee.

For early withdrawal due only to official transfer of a family – if the School will be informed by December, tuition fees will be prorated to one semester. For departures in the second semester, fees are due for the whole year (see below for more specs).

Additional specifications for students attending one semester only, Mid-Term Entry and Mid-Term Drop-Out:

1st Semester only: Fees for attendance for the First Semester only, or one trimester, are 60% of annual tuition plus 100% of Application and Entrance Fee. The Entrance Fee is to be paid within 15 days upon receiving the Acceptance Letter. The tuition is to be paid by September 30th.

2nd Semester only: Fees for attendance for the Second Semester only, or one trimester, are 60% of annual tuition plus 100% of Application and Entrance Fee. The Entrance Fee is to be paid within 15 days upon receiving the Acceptance Letter. The tuition is to be paid by January 31st.

Re-enrolment for the following academic year will be granted only if students are in good standing with payment of tuition and other fees.

School fees are billed once a year in March and they need to be paid in three instalments: end of March, end of August and end of December, as indicated here below

Wires from abroad

Please note: it is required to specify the Swift code of the beneficiary Bank: FEBIITM1 only for Euro wire transfers originated by Banks associated with Sepa group or for Sepa Direct Debit charges (direct debits to arrange payments within Sepa Countries). Should the wire transfer's originating Bank or the creditor company require an 11 digit code, XXX must be added at the end of the Swift code (FEBIITM1XXX). Instead, for any foreign currency wire transfer or for Euro wire transfers originated in non-Sepa countries, it is required to specify the Swift code of the receiving Bank: UNCRITMM, and the beneficiary bank Unicredit Spa. Should the wire transfer's originating Bank require an 11 digit code, XXX must be added at the end of the Swift code (UNCRITMMXXX).
